

Notice of the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board

This Notice is to advise that the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone will be effective on the Gas Bulletin Board (GBB) on 26 October 2015.

In accordance with Schedule 2 of the BB Procedures, the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone is described as deliveries to the LNG facilities on Curtis Island near Gladstone from LNG pipelines including Queensland Curtis LNG Pipeline¹, Australia Pacific LNG Pipeline and Gladstone LNG Pipeline. The Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone will become an operational demand zone from the beginning of the gas day commencing on 26 October 2015.

LNG pipelines delivering gas to the LNG facilities on the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone must make submissions and provide information required from 26 October 2015, by the times and in the manner required under Part 18 of the National Gas Rules.

The information required for BB Pipelines is:
