

Notice of Exemption Cancellation and Registration of Wallumbilla to Gladstone Pipeline on the Natural Services Gas Bulletin Board

The Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO), as the Bulletin Board (BB) Operator is hereby giving notice that the exemption declaration granted on 21 August 2015 for the Wallumbilla to Gladstone Pipeline on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board is revoked, effective 26 October 2015.

In accordance with the conditions of the exemption declaration, this is to reflect the declaration of Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone, which will be effective on 26 October 2015 in the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board Procedures, as per the notice published on 16 October 2015. AEMO considered that the Wallumbilla to Gladstone Pipeline no longer meets the criteria as per the declaration exemption published on 25 August 2015 as the facility will deliver gas to the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone (540030).

AEMO, as the BB Operator is hereby giving notice that it has registered the Wallumbilla to Gladstone Pipeline on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board, effective 26 October 2015.

Registration is based on the following information provided by Queensland Gas Company, operator (AEMO operator number 106) of the Wallumbilla to Gladstone Pipeline.

- The facility will commence reporting its Standing Capacity from effective gas day 26 October 2015.
- The facility will commence reporting its day-ahead data (Capacity Outlook, Linepack Adequacy Flag, and Delivery Nomination) from gas day 27 October 2015.
- The facility will commence reporting its Actual Flow from gas day 26 October 2015.
- The facility will deliver gas into the Curtis Island LNG Demand Zone (540030).

In accordance with clause 154(2)(c) of the Natural Gas Rules, AEMO has included the facility in the BB facilities list with effect from 26 October 2015.
