Notice of the Enhanced Information Rule Change on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board

This Notice is to advise that the Australian Energy Market Commission's determination on Enhanced Information for Gas Transmission Pipeline Capacity Trading will be effective on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board (GGB) on 6 October 2016.

In line with this, the release of changes into Production environment will be undertaken on Wednesday 5 October 2016 and the rule change will become operational on the GGB from the beginning of the gas day commencing on 6 October 2016. BB participants must submit information required from 6 October 2016, by the times and in the manner required under Part 18 of the National Gas Rules and in accordance with the [BB Procedures \(version 7\)](#).

The following table provides a list of the information BB Participants should submit as well as the gas days covered, and the timeline for publication of the various reports.
